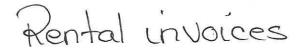

2.0 DESIGN PHASE DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

- **5.2 BILLING:** Payment is due on receipt of invoice and shall be paid within 7 days. Any objections to the billing must be made within (14) days, in writing, or those objections are waived. A service charge of 1.5% per month will be added to any invoice unpaid by CLIENT after 30 days. The CONSULTANT has the right to suspend its service and/or terminate this Agreement, without any liability to the CONSULTANT, if payment is not made when due. In the event the CONSULTANT must institute action to collect money owed under this CONTRACT, then the prevailing party shall be entitled to its reasonable attorney's fees and expert witness fees and costs incurred therein.

5.3 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: To the fullest extent permitted by law, and not withstanding any other provisions of this CONTRACT or the existence of the current insurance coverage at the time of services, that the total liability arising out of or in any way related to this Agreement, CONSULTANT, or the project, from any theory or cause of action, including but not limited to negligence, strict liability, indemnity, breach of contract, shall not exceed the total compensation received by the CONSULTANT under this Agreement or amount covered by the current liability insurance, whichever is greater. If the CONSULTANT provides construction phase services, the CONSULTANT shall have no responsibility for any contractor's means, methods, techniques, equipment choice and usage, sequence, schedule, safety programs, or safety practices, nor shall CONSULTANT have any authority or responsibility to stop or direct the work of any contractor. The CONSULTANT'S visits will be for the purpose of endeavoring to provide the Client a greater degree of confidence that the completed work of its contractors will generally conform to the construction documents prepared by the CONSULTANT. CONSULTANT neither guarantees the performance of contractors, nor assumes responsibility for any contractor's failure to perform its work in accordance with the contract documents. The CONSULTANT is not responsible for any duties assigned to the design professional in the construction contract that are not expressly provided for in this CONTRACT. WHEREAS, the EAST KERN HEALTH CARE DISTRICT is committed to preserving and nurturing public access and participation in meetings of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of EAST KERN HEALTH CARE DISTRICT's legislative bodies are open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act, (CA Gov. Code 54950-54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and watch the District's legislative bodies conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code Section 54953(e), makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code Section 53953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, a required condition is that a state of emergency is declared by the Governor pursuant to Government Code Section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state caused by conditions as described in Government Code Section 8558; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation is made when there is an actual incident, threat of disaster, or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the jurisdictions that are within the District's boundaries, caused by natural, technological, or human-caused disasters; and

WHEREAS, it is further required that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, or, the legislative body meeting in person would present eminent risk to the health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, such conditions now exist in the District, specifically, proclaiming the existence of COVID-19, increases in Kern County and the State of California; and

WHEREAS, meeting in person would present eminent risk to health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors does hereby find that as COVID-19 cases are on the rise in Kern County has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the District that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment,

and facilities of the District, and desires to proclaim a local emergency and ratify the proclamation of state of emergency by the Governor of the State of California and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the local emergency, the Board of Directors does hereby find that the legislative bodies of EAST KERN HEALTH CARE DISTRICT shall conduct their meetings without compliance without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code Section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of Section 54953, and that such legislative body shall comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meeting as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of Section 54953; and

WHEREAS, the District continues to social distance via Zoom meetings, and other means of social distancing, nevertheless allowing unlimited Zoom access to meetings to the public.

SO NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF EAST KERN HEALTH CARE DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The Recitals set forth are true and correct and are incorporated into the Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Proclamation of Local Emergency. The Board hereby proclaims that a local emergency now exists throughout the District and meeting in person would expose individuals to possible exposure of COVID-19 transmissions.

Section 3. Ratification of Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency. The Board hereby ratifies the Governor of the State of California's Proclamation of State of Emergency, effective as of its issuance date of November 1, 2021

Section 4. Remote Teleconference Meetings. The Board President, Karen Macedonio and legislative bodies of EAST KERN HEALTH CARE DISTRICT are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including conducting open and public meetings with the Government Code Section 54953 (e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

Section 5. Effective Date of Resolution. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be effective until the earlier of DECEMBER 31, 2022, or such time the Board of Directors adopts a subsequent resolution in accordance with Government Code Section 54953 (e)(3) to extend the time during which the legislative bodies of EAST KERN HEALTH CARE DISTRICT may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Section 54953.

1) Purpose and Scope.

This agreement establishes the terms of employment for the District to employ Barbara J. Lindsay to serve as EKHCD Administrative Manager. Part-Time Employee desires to accept employment as set forth herein.

2) Duties of the Administrative Manager.

Employee shall work part-time as Administrative Manager of the District to exercise the powers and perform the duties specified in the Local Health Care District Law and East Kern Health Care District Administrative Code. Duties will include, but may not be limited to:

- Monitor and follow up on all incoming physical mail and email.
- Identify all documents that need to be preserved as Public Records
- Monitor and follow up on all tenant and property concerns

3) Term.

This Agreement commences on the date written above and continues until terminated by either party.

- 4) Salary.
 - a) District shall pay Part-Time Employee according to the following schedule: \$23.00 per hour
 - b) Employee is expected to work 10-20 hours per week.
- 5) Termination.
 - a) This Agreement for Employment is made at-will. Part-Time Employee may terminate or be terminated from employment with or without cause with 14 days' prior written notice. Part-Time Employee may respond to the Notice of Termination.
 - b) Part-Time Employee shall provide the District with at least 14 ("Fourteen") days' prior written notice of Part-Time Employee's resignation or inability to continue to perform the duties of the Administrative Manager. If Part-Time Employee is unable to perform the duties of Administrative Manager due to permanent disability, Part-Time Employee shall provide as much advance notice as feasible.

6) Other Terms and Conditions.

District may, from time-to-time, establish additional terms and conditions of employment, provided such terms and conditions are consistent with the provision of this Agreement and any applicable law.
